History of NSS

- **The National Service Scheme (NSS) is an Indian Government-sponsored Public Service**
- **programme conducted by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports of the Government of India.**
- **NSS was launched in Gandhiji's Centenary year, 1969, aimed at developing student's personality through community service, is a voluntary association of young people in Universities, Colleges and at +2 level working for a campus-community linkage.**
- **In May 1969, a conf student representatives (of universities and institutions of higher education) convened by the Ministry of Education and the University Grants Commission also unanimously agreed that a national-service scheme could be an instrument for national integration. The details were soon worked out and the Planning Commission sanctioned an outlay of Rs. 5 crores for the NSS during the Fourth Five-Year Plan..**

Symbol of NSS

- The symbol for the NSS has been based on the Giant Rath Wheel of the world-famous Konark Sun Temple (The Black Pagoda) situated in Odissa, India.
- The wheel portrays the cycle of creation, preservation and release. It signifies the movement in life across time and space.
- The eight bars in the wheel represents 24 hours of a day.
- The **red colour** indicates that the volunteer is full of young blood that is lively, active, energetic and full of high spirit.
- The **navy blue color** indicates the cosmos of which the NSS is tiny part, ready to contribute its share for the welfare of the mankind.
- It stands for continuity as well as change and implies the continuous striving of NSS for social transformation and uplift..

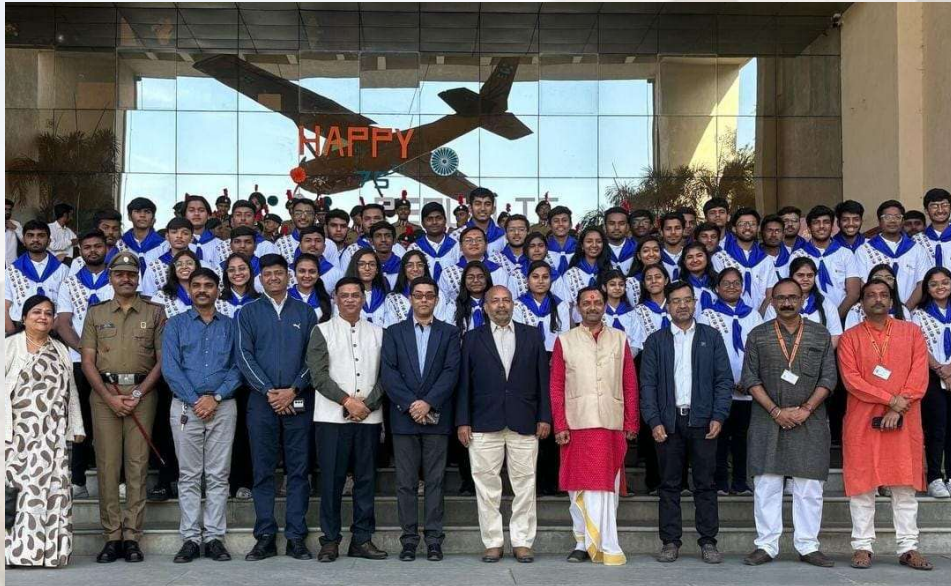
Aims and Objectives of NSS

Volunteer service at Polio vaccination – 01-07-2024



National Immunization Day (NID) commonly known as Pulse Polio Immunization programme was launched in India in 1995, and is conducted twice in early part of each year. Additionally multiple rounds (at least two) of sub national immunization day (SNID) have been conducted over the years in high risk states/areas. In these campaigns, children in the age group of 0-5 years are administered polio drops. NSS Volunteers contributed their service at this campaign in **PHC Center Ranchada .**

The second biggest yatra after Puri, 147th Rath Yatra of Lord Jagannath rolled out on 7th July 2024 in Gujarat's Ahmedabad city where a large number of devotees flocked the procession route to pay obeisance to the deity. The Rath Yatra is taken out on the Ashadhi Beej (second day of Hindu Ashadh month) every year. NSS Volunteers of Indus University contributed in various SEVA activities during this mega event.

Ek pad Maa ke Naam (Tree plantation drive)



“Ek Pad Maa ke Naam” the urban forest campaign was Inspired by Hon’ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi’s nationwide which aims to bring this initiative to urban areas, the Urban Forest Campaign will be held across the state until August 31, 2024. NSS volunteers of Indus University contributed at Tree plantation program organized by Santej Police Station, Kalol. Total 50 trees were planted on said event by 15 NSS Volunteers of IU. Students were briefed about the responsibilities of citizen and various departments of police substation by PI Shri SR Mucchal sir and his team.

Thalassemia checking camp (25-07-2024)



Thalassemia is a genetic blood disorder that affects the production of hemoglobin, which is responsible for carrying oxygen to all parts of the body. The disease can have life-long effects on individuals and in severe cases may even be fatal. Therefore, it is essential to diagnose thalassemia as early as possible. Early detection also helps prevent more serious medical complications from occurring. Thalassemia can cause anemia, which is a decrease in red blood cell count. If left untreated, this can lead to fatigue, heart problems and other serious health issues. Indus Institute of Pharmacy and Research at Indus University hosted a Thalassemia awareness and testing camp in collaboration with the Indian Red Cross Society, Gujarat state branch and NSS unit. 41 students and 2 faculty members took participation in this event which was coordinated by 10 NSS volunteers.

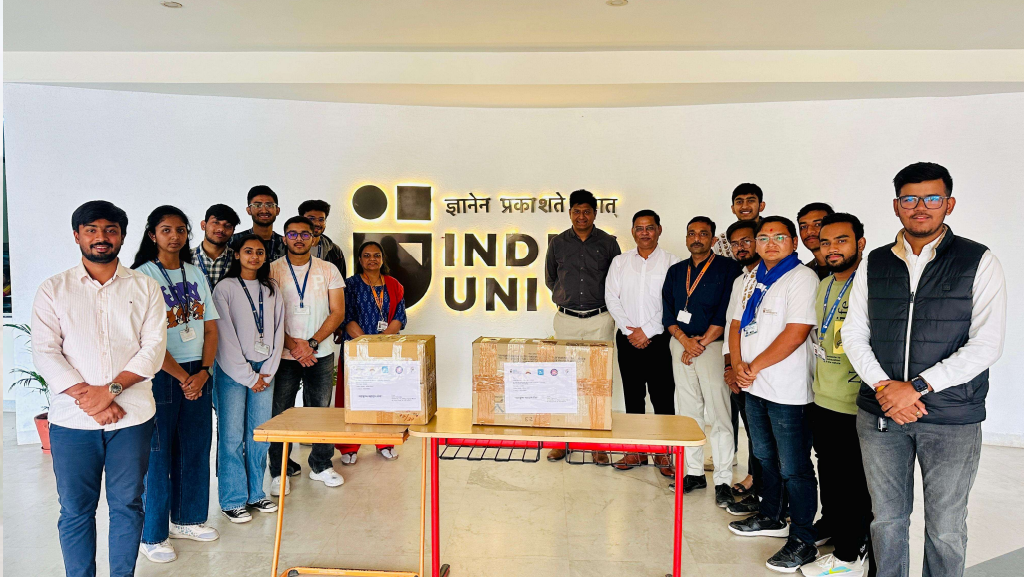


Medicine collection drive in Mahakumbh (30-01-2025 to 06-02-2025)

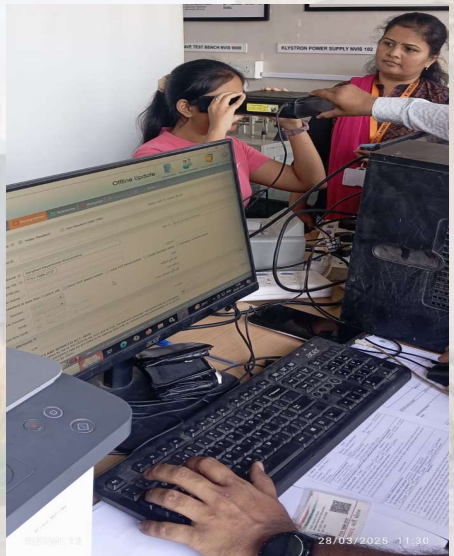
Blood Donation Camp- 12-05-2025
