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
WEBINAR ON INTERACTIVE BUILDINGS










WINTER COLLABORATIVE PROGRAM HANDS-ON WITH MANAVKRUTI, PUNE

TRAIN THE TRAINER – IP AWARENESS & FILING PATENTS



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






WORKSHOP ON UI/UX DESIGN



SPOTLIGHT Interview with Mr. K.S.R Swamy, DGM-Training and Placement

Interviewer: Could you share a little about yourself?

Mr. Swamy: My journey of 75 years has been filled with both challenges and triumphs. I take pride in being selfmade and self-reliant. Life has thrown many obstacles my way, and I continue to face them with resilience. I have always risen from adversity with determination, embodying the spirit of a fighter. A true workaholic, I dedicate 19 hours a day to my passion—students. My academic journey was marked by struggles, particularly financial hardships. I was the only male student to graduate BA from my class. However, my father instilled in me a strong sense of discipline, which has been the cornerstone of my success.

Interviewer: What prompted you to move out of Andhra Pradesh?

Mr. Swamy: I left Andhra Pradesh during a period of unrest when the entire state was under curfew. My journey took me to Ahmedabad, and coincidentally, while I was on the train, I received a job offer from ACC—my mother's dream job for me. However, due to limited communication at the time, I was unaware of it. Upon arriving in Ahmedabad in 1972, opportunities began to unfold. I joined the Sarabhai Group, which felt more like a family than a workplace. Later, I had the privilege of working with the Ambani Group, where my role required daily interaction with top management. This experience allowed me to connect with some of the country's most influential industrialists.

Interviewer: Before transitioning to academics, which industries did you work in, and what challenges did you encounter?

Mr. Swamy: I began my career as a Client Servicing Executive, reporting to Smt. Gira Sarabhai, Chairperson of the Sarabhai Group—a remarkable mentor who taught me corporate ethics, discipline, and punctuality. My journey started in the advertising industry, where I managed end-to-end advertising strategies, media planning, creative execution, and client approvals for companies like Calico Mills and Sarabhai Chemicals. I then moved to Navneetlal and Company, handling clients such as GSFC (Baroda), ABS Plastics, and Dhara Groundnut Oil for 14 years. In 1988, I joined Mudra Communication (Ambani Group), where I played a key role in land acquisition and the construction of MICA, along with overseeing various functions of the Chairman's Office.

Interviewer: Can you walk us through your academic journey?

Mr. Swamy: After my tenure at Mudra Communication, I transitioned to academia in 2005, joining ICFAI Business School as a Corporate Manager, focusing on placements and other activities. Later, I spent a decade at Marwadi University as the Head of Training and Placement/Corporate Affairs. I established the Training and Placement Department, single-handedly managing placement-related activities for the first three years. I successfully organized two consecutive placement weeks, attracting over 90 companies and ensuring job offers for all students. My journey then led me to Indus University as the Head of University Placement, where I facilitated recruitment drives with renowned companies like Micron, SKF, POSCO, Keyence, Godrej, Valorx, and Synoptek, offering salary packages ranging from ₹6-18 LPA.





Interviewer: After spending 30 years in the corporate world, what motivated you to switch to academia? **Mr. Swamy:** I wanted to explore new avenues and leverage my corporate expertise and network to guide students. My goal has always been to groom young minds and prepare them for the corporate world across various institutions and disciplines.

Interviewer: Can you tell us a little about your family?

Mr. Swamy: I live with my daughter and grandson. Unfortunately, my wife suffered from an enlarged heart condition.

Interviewer: What message would you like to share with the younger generation?

Mr. Swamy: Passion is lacking in today's youth. To succeed, you must pour your heart and soul into whatever you do. Always seek the blessings of your parents by touching their feet—it will lead you to prosperity. Be passionate, cultivate a fire within, and seize every opportunity that comes your way.
