RHAPSODY

The best performer in each category will be announced as the winner based on the scoring. Categories:

- 1. Classical Music

Each category includes singing and instrumental performances under the following formats:

Selection Process:

- No verbal or written communication is allowed during acting.
- Each round has a time limit of 1 minute.
- The team with the most correct guesses wins.
- ID-card is mandatory for participation.

3) Thrive & Conquer:

A multi-stage challenge testing participants' problem-solving, endurance, and strategy.

Rules:

- Teams of 3-5 members must complete tasks to proceed to the next level.
- Tasks may include physical challenges, quizzes, and strategic games.
- Teams must complete each task within the allocated time.
- Cheating or unsportsmanlike behavior will lead to disqualification.
- The team with the best overall performance wins.



RAMAT GAMAT

1) Satoliyu:

- The player with the ball throws it at the pile of stones, attempting to knock them over.
- While the ball is in play, the other players must dodge it to avoid getting hit.
- If a player is hit by the ball, they are out for that round.
- If the stones are knocked over, the player who threw the ball must try to rebuild the pile while the other players retrieve the ball and try to hit the rebuilding player with it.
- If a player successfully hits the rebuilding player with the ball before they finish rebuilding the pile, that player is out for that round.
- If the rebuilding player successfully rebuilds the pile before getting hit, they win the round.
- The game continues with the winner of the previous round starting the next round with the ball.

2) Tyre Race:

- The first player from each team or individual player rolls the tire from the starting line to the finish line.
- The tire must be rolled with the hands, and the player must run alongside the tire.
- If the tire falls over or leaves the designated area, the player must return to the starting line and begin again.
- Once a player successfully rolls the tire to the finish line, they tag the next player on their team, who repeats the process until all team members have completed the race.
- The team that finishes the race first wins.







3) Kancha:

- The players take turns trying to knock the other players' kanchas out of the circle.
- To begin their turn, a player places one of their kanchas outside the circle and uses another kancha to try and hit it into the circle.
- If the player's kancha lands inside the circle, they get to go again.
- If the player's kancha hits an opponent's kancha and knocks it out of the circle, the player gets to keep both kanchas.
- If the player's kancha lands outside the circle, or they miss hitting their own kancha, their turn ends and the next player takes a turn.
- The game continues until one player has collected all the kanchas or a predetermined number of rounds have been played.

4) Rumal Chor:

- The objective of the game is to capture the handkerchief and bring it to your own team's designated area.
- At the start of the game, all players begin at their own designated area.
- When the game starts, players run towards the center of the play area to grab the handkerchief.
- Once a player has the handkerchief, they must try to bring it back to their own designated area
- without getting tagged by a player from the other team.
- If a player is tagged while holding the handkerchief, they must drop it and return to their own
- designated area.
- The game continues until a player successfully brings the handkerchief back to their own team's
- designated area.



5) Three Legged Race:

- On the signal to start, the first player from each team begins hopping or running together towards the finish line.
- The three-legged teams must stay connected at the tied legs throughout the race.
- If a team becomes untied or loses their balance and falls, they must stop and reattach their legs before continuing.
- Teams must remain within the designated race area, and if they stray outside, they must return to the
- point of exit and continue from there.
- Once a three-legged team successfully reaches the finish line, they tag the next team member, who continues the race.

XENOS

1) Wall painting

The participants have to make wall painting according to theme given without using brush. Participants can make group of 3-4 members.

Rules:-

- Each team must have 3-4 members.
- Participants can use fingers, sponges, cloth, spray, or any other creative tools except brushes.
- Teams will get 1 hour 30 min to complete their artwork.
- Participants must bring their own colors and materials (paints, sponges, rollers, cloth, stencils, etc.). Only the wall/drawing surface will be provided.
- Cutters, blades, knives, or any sharp objects are strictly prohibited.





2) Complete the Canvas

Collaborative painting challenge where two participants work on a single artwork but with a twist!. After a set interval, they must exchange canvases and continue the other person's work. The challenge is to create a seamless and meaningful composition together.

Rules:-

- Only the drawing sheet/canvas will be provided; participants must bring their own colors, brushes, and materials.
- Each team consists of 2 participants.
- After every 5 minutes, they must swap and continue their partner's painting.
- No stencils or pre-made designs are allowed—everything must be hand-drawn/painted.

AAKAR

1) Photowalk:

Rules and Guidelines

- Registration: Participants must register in advance to secure a spot in the photowalk.
- Timeliness: Participants must arrive 30 minutes before the scheduled start for briefing.

- Judges' decisions are final and binding.
