1) Photowalk:

Rules and Guidelines

- Registration: Participants must register in advance to secure a spot in the photowalk.
- Timeliness: Participants must arrive 30 minutes before the scheduled start for briefing.
- Theme: A specific theme or subject may be provided; participants should align their shots accordingly.
- Equipment: Any type of camera (DSLR, mirrorless, smartphone, or film) is allowed. Participants must bring their own gear.
- Respect Public Spaces: Follow local laws and respect private property while taking photographs.
- No Disturbance: Avoid causing inconvenience to pedestrians, vendors, or local businesses.

- Safety First: Follow safety guidelines, especially in crowded or hazardous areas.
- No Editing Restrictions: Basic editing (color correction, cropping, etc.) is allowed, but extreme manipulation is discouraged.
- Submission Deadline: If photographs are to be judged, they must be submitted within the given timeframe.
- Judging Criteria (if applicable): Photos will be evaluated based on composition, creativity, adherence to the theme, and overall impact.
- Code of Conduct: Any inappropriate behavior, damage to property, or violation of rules may lead to disqualification.
